2010 OHIO STATE INDOOR PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP

DATE: April 10 & 11, 2010

SPONSOR: Ohio Rifle and Pistol Association. Hosted by the Oak Harbor Conservation Club.

FIRING SCHEDULE: Matches will begin at 9:00 AM on Sat. April 10 and Sun. April 11. Two or three relays per day. 12 competitors per relay. On each day, relay one will fire .22 Cal. SF on 50 yd. range at 9:00 a.m. Immediately following, Relay one will fire .22 cal sustained fire on 25 yd. Range. Relays two and three to follow immediately and in sequence. Approximate firing time Relay two is 9:40 a.m. and Relay three 10:20 a.m. Centerfire and 45 matches will follow in the same sequence. NOTE: All slow fire refires will be fired after the final relay or at the discretion of the Match Director.

RULES: Current NRA Rules shall govern in all cases.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA classification will be used. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual member of the NRA. Additionally, Ohio residents must be a member of the Ohio Rifle and Pistol Association and must present their membership card. Residents of other states may present their home state Association membership card in lieu of joining ORPA. ORPA individual membership is \$25.00 per year and may be paid at the registration desk.

REGISTRATION: Please call or write to the address below accompanied by a check (payable to Oak Harbor Conservation Club Match Fund), money order, or NRA points. Entries should be made by the Friday preceding the match. Confirmation will be sent for entries received up to seven days prior to the match. Please include your phone number with your entry.
